Tardies to school began as being counted on January 13. While tardies to school from last semester were "erased", these quickly begin to accumulate.



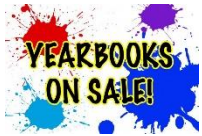
CIS needs your continued support! Please assist with the Spring Musical, "GREASE" -

(To further protect our students, the Session Law 2019 - 245 (SB 199) was recently passed in November 2019. This is an Act to Protect Children from Sexual Abuse and to Strengthen and Modernize Sexual Assault Laws. The act, now new law includes training requirements for all school personnel who work directly with students. Our staff at CIS was trained 2 years ago and will be trained again this school year).
